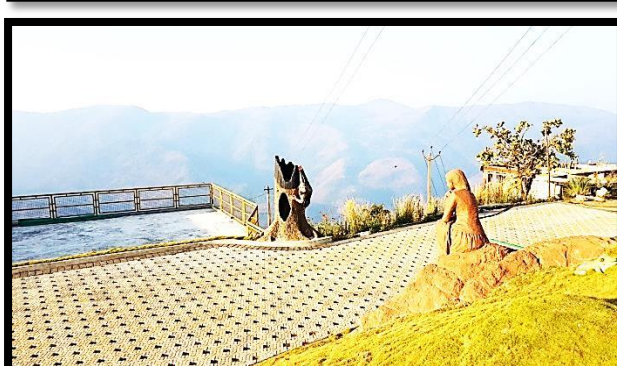
All members are requested to attend the induction event with family on time at Valavi hall on Thursday at 7:00 pm (23 Feb).

8th Board Meeting

Date: 10th Feb 2017/Venue: Hotel Mercy/Time: 6:30pm

Started with a silent prayer

President Murali Nair welcomed all the members to the 8th Board.

Last board meeting minutes presented by the Secretary and approved it in the meeting.

President started with congratulating Rtn. Arif for successfully completing his mission of selecting new president for Beachside for the year 17-18. The President also congratulated Mr. Vincent Varghese for accepting the mantle for next Rotary Year, and all the board members available joined the appreciation for Vincent.

Prezy Murali Nair further informed the board that CVs of all the new members wanting to join Beachside, have circulated to the Beachsiders, and about the plan to induct them on Thursday 23rd February coinciding with the celebrations of Balaji's daughter wedding evening. The board unanimously concurred the proposal.

Rtn. Sanal suggested the venue of Valavi hall @ Rs. 2000/- which has been approved by the board.

President further congratulated Rtn. Anil Jacob and Rtn. Sanal Kumar for bringing new members to Beachside.

Prezy informed the meeting about the impending joint meeting with all the city clubs at hotel Fern on Tue 14th Feb 2017 to honor the visiting GSE (Group study exchange) Rotarians from Australia. This joint meet is – though organized by the District – being practically managed by the 7 clubs (7C's) under our AG Bibu Punnooran, so we -Beachside too has a role to play, being technically the host club. The contribution from the each club is Rs.4000/- but from the host clubs might have to pay a little extra if there is a shortage of collections. The Board has given go ahead for it unanimously.

The board approved hotel bills of 12,600, gold coin gift for Mis. Nikitha Balaji and other petty expenses related to the induction of new members, i.e. Induction kit, flower buds, pins, hall rent, soft drinks etc.

President informed the board that the dist. project of Mobile Mammogram unit is getting ready and the district requested a letter from each club for its utilization.

As Suggested by Rtn. Balaji, Beachside will request for its services for two days, one day at Panangad, and one day for Beachside family in city side. Its expenses like driver cost, food for the team and etc. will have to be borne by the club.

President reminded the board for the need to collect and contribute for the TRF as DG himself is pressing for it. Rtn. Radhakrishnan will be talking to the members again soon to finalize it.

Meeting cancellation issue was discussed. All members agreed with the president that the members should acknowledge the messages being sent out from president or secretary particularly about the meetings. Confirmation of attendance or otherwise from the members must be notified by Wed evening or latest by Thursday morning in order to confirm the meeting and to confirm with hotel Mercy. It's very embarrassing to cancel the meeting on Friday noon time with Mercy.

AT this time one of the members insisted that meeting shall not be cancelled and will be conducted even if there is only 1 member – but President vetoed it indicating the related expenses to be paid to the hotel and in the absence of required quorum where no decision or healthy decision can be taken.

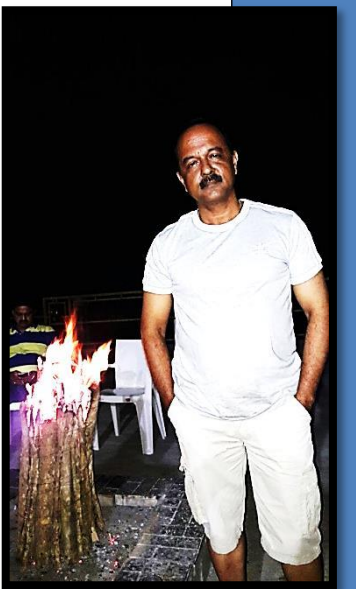


Joint meeting with all the city clubs on 14th Feb 2017 to honor the GSE team Tasmania Australia at Hotel Fern Cochin
